PUBLISHING AGREEMENT

Between the journal *Revue économique* (hereafter the Journal), and the Author named above:

Whereas the issues of the Journal is a collective work pursuant to articles L. 113-2 and L. 113-5 of the *Code de la propriété intellectuelle* [French Intellectual Property Code], in which the Journal holds the intellectual property rights.

The Author agrees to contribute to this collective work under the following conditions:

Preamble:

The Journal has assigned its publishing rights to the Presses de Sciences Po (hereafter the Publisher).

Art. 1. **Object of this agreement:** this agreement concerns the publication of the above article and the assignment of all associated rights.

Art. 2. **Submitting your article:** the Author undertakes to submit the definitive and complete version of his/her article to the Journal as an electronic file. The article submitted will comply with the formatting and markup guidelines set out by the Journal, and will have been carefully proofread and corrected before submission. This agreement only becomes definitive when the parties to it have agreed that the article submitted is the final complete version.

Art. 3. **The Journal's responsibilities:** The Journal warrants that it will publish the article under the terms of this agreement. It will use its best efforts to ensure the proper integration of the article within the journal issue and, given the collective nature of the work, will seek to make it consistent with the other articles published in the issue.

Art 4. **The Author's responsibilities:** The Author will ensure that his/her article conforms to the Journal's technical and stylistic specifications. S/he accepts that essential editorial changes may be made to his/her article as a result of the nature of the issue and of the Journal's readership.

The Author warrants that the article submitted is an original work. If the article reproduces or uses, wholly or in part, any work of intellectual property not in the public domain, the Author warrants that s/he has obtained the appropriate permissions to include such text, illustrations, content of illustrations, or any other element to be included in the final published article. The Author agrees to provide copies of all correspondence and documentation concerning such permissions to the Journal.

S/he indemnifies the Journal against all claims or loss of rights due to third party actions in respect of copyright infringements, or any other breach of the warranties made by the Author under the terms of this agreement.

Art. 5. Assignment of rights:

The Author assigns to the Journal exclusive rights of reproduction, performance, and adaptation in respect of the article. These exclusive rights may be exercised by the Publisher or sublicensed to a third party for the full period of copyright throughout the world, in all languages, and in all media or formats now known or hereafter discovered, either singly or as a component in a larger collection.

- Reproduction rights include the right to reproduce the article in all media or formats now known or hereafter discovered, including, but not limited to, in magazine, book, or other printed format, and in all types of electronic media enabling the article to be stored digitally, either temporarily or on a permanent basis.

- Performance rights include the right to broadcast the article via all telecommunication methods now known or hereafter discovered, and in particular via the Internet.
- Adaptation rights include the right to translate the article, to adapt it to the delivery medium in question, and to include it in compilations with other works.

The Author also assigns all rights associated with reprographic copying of his/her article in accordance with article L. 122-10 of the *Code de la propriété intellectuelle* [French Intellectual Property Code].

Under the terms of this Agreement, the Author may not submit to another publisher an article on the same topic adopting the same approach, or presented in similar fashion, without the written consent of the Journal and the Publisher.

Art 6. **Scholarly uses:** as described in the attached appendix, the Author, the Journal, and the Publisher may make certain non-commercial uses of the article.

Art 7. **Offprints and journal sample copy :** the Publisher shall provide 20 free e-offprints (PDFs) and one printed copy of the journal issue featuring the Author's article.

Art 8. **Technological measures relating to protection and information:** the Publisher may employ technological measures relating to protection/information in its different operations. Using such measures may be the result of business or technological decisions, specifically in relation to managing access to the Article, protecting intellectual property rights, and identifying the Article and its uses. At the written request of the Author, the Publisher will set out the key features of such measures.

Art. 9. **Dispute resolution:** Any dispute arising in relation to the present agreement shall be subject to a process of mediation before legal action is taken.

Appendix: scholarly uses

1. Subject to the rights assigned to the Publisher under the present Agreement, the Author may :
 - Archive the preprint (the Author's original version of the manuscript before peer review) of his/her Article on his/her institutional server
 - Distribute the preprint within his/her institution, including on an institutional intranet, excluding all direct and indirect commercial uses. Access to the article is to be strictly limited to members of the institution.
 - Copy the preprint for the purposes of his/her own teaching or attendance at a conference, and distribute it solely to his/her students or conference attendees.
 - Self-archive in an open format the Accepted Version of the manuscript on non-commercial online repositories or archives, subject to an embargo period of 12 months following publication of the Version of Record as requested by article L. 533-4 of the "Loi pour une République numérique".

The Author shall inform the Publisher in advance of the uses s/he intends to make of his/her article, and all such uses shall acknowledge the Publisher and the collection in which the Article appears, including a link to the published version.

The Author may not distribute the published version of the article (the Version of Record). This version, including all elements comprising its manufacture, presentation and format for which the Publisher or a third party contracted by the Publisher is responsible, remains the sole property of the Publisher. Only the Publisher may make commercial use of the Version of Record.

The Publisher must explicitly agree to all uses of the article made by the Author, or entrusted by the author to a third party, both in France and abroad. A lack of response from the Publisher shall not be construed by the Author as agreement.

Acknowledgement of the Publisher and the collection in which the Article appears must be included in all uses of the Article. Any publication of the preprint or Accepted Version online must be accompanied by a visible link permitting easy access to the Version of Record on a commercial or archival platform and/or to the Publisher's site on which the collection to which the article belongs appears.

2. The Publisher warrants that it will make the Version of Record freely available to the public one year after its publication by any means that it chooses.
